

## As We Gather

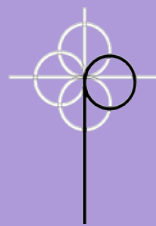
When our Lord entered time and space He was rejected, much as the son of the vineyard owner in the

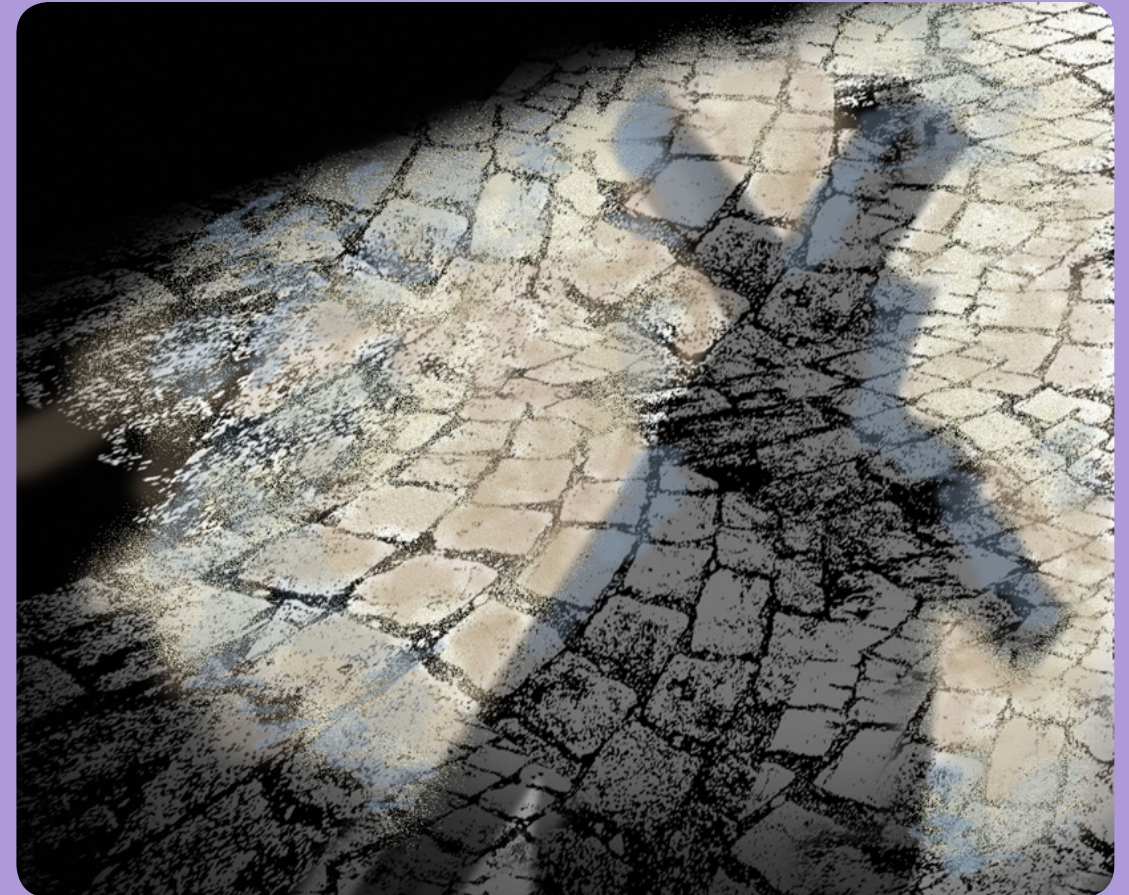
